

# How to fill out your Vehicle Access Permit tag

**Your Vehicle Access Permit:** If you've purchased a vehicle access permit you will receive a confirmation email from Queensland Parks and Wildlife Service. You can either print your permit tag, or collect a sticker from Micat to display when you get to the island.

## Vehicle Access Permit

*Your access to Queensland's recreation areas*

Permit must be attached to the lower left side of the vehicle's windscreen or, if the vehicle does not have a windscreen, another prominent position on the vehicle.

Invalid or expired vehicle tags must not be displayed on the vehicle.

Vehicles must be registered and have a valid recreation area vehicle access permit.

On the back are some handy tips to help you survive your drive.

*Copy your booking details onto the back of this sheet. Keep it in your glove box for future reference.*

## Enjoy your visit to national parks and recreation areas.

Smoking is prohibited within 10 metres of any visitor facilities in this park including toilets, picnic tables, jetties and occupied camp sites.

Dogs are not permitted in national parks or recreation areas including the beach to low water mark and inside vehicles. Dogs must remain onboard vessels in marine parks and are not permitted in intertidal areas next to national parks.

### Where can you drive?

Drive on the harder sand between the waterline and the high tide mark for the firmest surface.

Remember that other people use the beach, so stay alert, follow Queensland road rules and drive carefully!

Make sure you know any local rules about using vehicles on beaches. Do the right thing and other drivers will follow your good example.

Slow down and go around people and wildlife.

### Where can't you drive?

Keep off sand dunes except at designated crossing points for access to and from the beach.

Vehicles shouldn't be driven on sandy areas along the debris or drift lines as these are potential sites for the formation of new dunes.

Plants growing on or near these lines trap windblown sand to form new dunes.

*Vehicle access permit fees are used to improve facilities for visitors and manage visitor impacts.*

## VEHICLE TAG

This tag must be prominently displayed face up on the left hand side of your vehicles dashboard or windscreen so it can be seen by a QPWS Ranger upon inspection.
